



Code of conduct — players, coaches and parents

This code applies to everyone at our tournaments: players, coaches, parents, officials, volunteers and spectators.

1. Respect on and off court

Shake hands with your opponents and the umpire after every match. Accept line calls and decisions without argument; ask the umpire, calmly, if you need a rule explained.

2. Coaches and parents

Coaching is given between rallies from the coach's chair only. Parents support from the stands and never address the umpire or the opponents during play.

3. Fair play

Enter in your true grade, play every match to win, and never agree a result in advance. Deliberate delays and abuse of equipment are misconduct.

4. Sanctions

The referee may warn, award a fault against, or disqualify a player. Serious or repeated misconduct is reported to the tournament office, which may refuse future entries.

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
